If no money was paid to advertise the roles, please indicate this on the spreadsheet.

3. For an email address and contact information for the HR department or relevant department responsible for publishing and promoting vacancies within the service.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

- Leicestershire Police and The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire only pay external organisations to advertise vacant police staff roles.
- 2. Leicestershire Police and The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire paid the below in the requested financial years for advertising:
 - a. 2015/16 No requirement for external job advertising
 - b. 2016/17 £2,700
 - c. 2017/18 £2,700
