Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your freedom of information request received on 12 March 2023. I note you seek access to the following information:

The leaflet provided with Council Tax Bills for 2023/24, the PCC claims to have provided more PCSOs.

However, the local LibDems have publicly claimed the opposite - that PCSO numbers have reduced.

Can you please clarify and confirm specifically the data you have used & what is included/excluded etc. (eg trainees).

The information requested does not appear in the Council Tax letter 2023/24. In accordance with the FOI Act, I wish to offer further assistance to you with your request. Below, I set out information on particular records which we hold relating to the subject matter of your request:

Please could you clarify the document in which the PCC claims to have provided more PCSOs, we may then be able to proceed with consideration of your request.

Please be advised that under section 16(1) and 16 (2) Where a public authority asks for further clarification to enable the requester to meet the requirements of section 8, the 20 working days response period will not start until satisfactory reply constituting a valid request is received.

Please could you provide the clarification within 2 months of receiving this letter.
