Title: Amendments to 2013-14 Budget and Precept

Summary of Issue:

- 1. To amend the 2013-14 Budget and Precept proposals to reflect updated information received from district councils and the receipt of final funding notifications from the Home Office
- 2. District councils' precepting systems work to 2 decimal places, not 4 decimal places reported at both the Executive Board held on 30 January 2013 and the Police and Crime Panel held on the same day. This therefore requires the precept figure to be rounded to 2 decimal places consistent with 2012/13.
- 3. It has recently been announced that Leicestershire authorities will receive approximately £97.7k in council tax support transition grant. It is proposed that this sum is set aside in the Budget Equalisation Reserve to assist in meeting any collection shortfalls resulting from the new support schemes. Should the sum vary significantly from this amount then a further decision will be sought.

the same as that adopted in 2012-13, at a level of £173.87. This will result in an anticipated precept collection shortfall of £1,416.

3. That the council tax support transition grant of approximately £97.7k be set aside in the Budget Equalisation Reserve.
