Title: E-Commerce – South West Consortium

### Summary of Issue:

The attached documentation sets out the business benefits of joining the South West E-commerce Consortium of 23 forces, which are agreeing to implement the first e-commerce module of firearms licensing. The second module, which is in the early stages of being commissioned is for a national e-payment platform, for which Leicestershire have agreed to be a lead force.

In addition to the direct benefits of the e-payments system, it is also felt that being an early adopter of digital infrastructure will act as an enabler of the wider organisational change programme.

For the firearms system, there is a financial commitment of £38k, to be paid when the system is satisfactorily implemented, estimated to be in early 2014. Benefits of this system are estimated to be some £31k per annum based on current transaction volumes.

Further benefits will derive from the wider e-payments system, but these are subject to more detailed evaluation.

If this proposal is supported by the Commissioner, a Section 23 (of the Police Act 1996) agreement will be signed.

### Recommendations presented:

That this initiative is supported and the requisite Section 23 agreement is signed by the Commissioner.


