Title: Early Termination of Lease at Covert Building

### **Summary of Issue:**

Following a detailed discussion at the Strategic Assurance Board on the 28/6/16, the PCC approved the Force proposal to progress early termination of the lease of a covert building.

All staff have been or are being relocated and the building is not open to the public and does not specifically serve the local community. Therefore, on this occasion no Equalities or Community Impact Assessments are required.

#### **Financial Impact**

To progress this early termination, a one off payment as detailed within the Business Case would be required and it is proposed that this additional cost in 2017/18 is met by reserves unless there are sufficient underspends identified by the Force in 2017/18 to meet this. The cost of early termination is lower than the cost to retain.

This would enable ongoing savings of £25K per annum for Leicestershire to be realised in the Medium Term Financial Plan with effect from 2018/19 onwards.

That the PCC approve the early termination of the covert building in line with the June 2016 agreement and current proposal.
