Title: Police and Crime Commissioners (PCC) Prevention Fund – Round 4
Successful Bids

Summary of Issue:

In his Commissioning Framework for 2017/18, the Police and Crime Commissioner set aside funding for a grants programme, named the Police and Crime Commissioner's Prevention Fund. The fund set aside is up to £250,000 for the year and the purpose is to support the achievement of the objectives within the Police and Crime Plan.

The Prevention Fund is a rolling grants programme throughout the year and bid applications will be considered by the PCC on a monthly basis.

For any funding bids where a second years funding is approved, the second year funding is provided in principle subject to effective delivery and performance in year one.

Grants awarded- Round 4

During Round 4, the PCC received 10 bid applications. All applications were assessed in line with the Prevention Fund Grant criteria and on the 16.10.2017 all applications were presented to the PCC for consideration and approval.

The PCC reviewed these applications together with the officers present and the PCC agreed to fund 2 of the bid applications.

The PCC approved two Round 4 bids:

2017/18	£22,321.56	(2 bids)
2018/19	£12,499.80	(1 bid)

This equates to a further funding commitment for round 4 of £22,321.56 for 2017/18 and £12,499.80 for 2018/19

Total funding approved to Round 4 is £103,753.84 for 2017/18 and £31,276.22 for 2018/19. The balance of the fund after Round 4 is £146,246.16 for 2017/18 and £218,723.78 for 2018/19.

Further information and clarification is to be sought on three of the bids received in August. The decision whether these bids are to be funded will be made during round 5.
