**Title:** Police and Crime Commissioners (PCC) Prevention Fund – Round 5  
**Successful Bids**

### Summary of Issue:

In his Commissioning Framework for 2017/18, the Police and Crime Commissioner set aside funding for a grants programme, named the Police and Crime Commissioner's Prevention Fund. The fund set aside is up to £250,000 for the year and the purpose is to support the achievement of the objectives within the Police and Crime Plan.

The Prevention Fund is a rolling grants programme throughout the year and bid applications will be considered by the PCC on a monthly basis.

For any funding bids where a second years funding is approved, the second year funding is provided in principle subject to effective delivery and performance in year one.

### **Grants awarded- Round 5**

During Round 5, the PCC received 4 bid applications. All applications were assessed in line with the Prevention Fund Grant criteria and on the 31.10.17 all applications were presented to the PCC for consideration and final approval.

The PCC reviewed these applications together with the officers present and the PCC agreed to fund 3 of the bid applications.

The PCC approved three Round 5 bids:

2017/18	£19,950.00	(3 bids)
2018/19	£19,941.00	(2 bids)

This equates to a further funding commitment for round 5 of £19,950.00 for 2017/18 and £19,941.00 for 2018/19

Total funding approved to Round 5 is £123,703.84 for 2017/18 and £31,276.22 for 2018/19. The balance of the fund after Round 5 is £126,296.16 for 2017/18 and £218,723.78 for 2018/19.
