Title: CONT0208 Xplan Door Access System contract

Summary of Issue:

The current Xplan Door Access System contract expires 30th June this year and we are required to competitively tender the requirement. The spend is approximately £80,000 a year and the contract is currently with CVL Systems.

An invitation to tender was published on eu-supply.com, advertised on Find a Tender Service (FTS) and Contracts Finder.

We received three tenders from Casini Systems Ltd, CVL Systems and Reliance High-Tech Ltd. The most economical tender is from CVL Systems, which was approved by Paul Dawkins, Assistant Chief Officer (Finance & Resources) and I am seeking the Police Commissioner signature & seal to the contract

Background

The current contract (CON873) with CVL Systems expires 30th June. The spend has been approximately £80,000 a year as follows:

2021/22: £47,301.60, 2020/21: £125,818.44; 2019/20: £57,488.63. Average: £76,869.55

It was agreed to publish an above threshold open tender advertised on Contracts Finder and Finder a Tender, for a two-year contract with two optional 1-year extensions.

Tender Process

We published an open tender, advertising on FTS and Contracts Finder. We received tenders from Casini Systems Ltd, CVL Systems and Reliance High-Tech Ltd.

The evaluation scores are given below:
