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Title: Digital Forensics Transformational Project contract

Summary of Issue:

The Digital Hub are seeking to implement a greenfield deployment of a digital forensics network, on-premises, private cloud infrastructure, public cloud services used for data archiving, deployment of Magnet Forensics Digital Investigation Suite (MDIS) software and implementation of a fully managed service provision. The contract will be for five years with two optional extensions.

We requested Commercial Service (CCS) RM6100 Technology Services 3 framework suppliers on Lot 4 Major Services Transformation Programmes, to provide information and to express an interest.

We took forward the suppliers who responded and who met our mandatory criteria. Two companies tendered for the opportunity and we awarded the contract to Telefonica Tech as the most economically advantageous tender (best value).

The total price of the contract, including the two optional extensions is £8,891,393.00 (incliding the optional extensions).

Background

A Low-Level Design was used as a base to tender the requirements and it was agreed to publish a further competition using the Crown Commercial Service (CCS) RM6100 Technology Services 3 framework - Lot 4 Major Services Transformation Programmes

Tender Process

A request for information was issued as specified in the framework. We received expressions of interest from five companies. However, one company didn't meet our requirements on business continuity.

Two companies withdrew their interest during the tender process and we received two tenders. The evaluation is as follows:

The contract value is £6,317,977.00 with £2,573,416.00 for a two-year optional extension. The total value including the optional extension is £8,891,393.00.

The recommendation has been approved by Paul Dawkins, Assistant Chief Officer - Finance. The data protection measures approved by Steven Morris, Head of Data Management Services and Information Security has agreed that that the security design work in schedule 2.4 of the contract can be populated post contract award. Legal Service have reviewed the framework terms & conditions and I included supplementary terms at their request.

Recommendation(s) presented:

I recommendation that we award the Digital Forensics Transformational Project opportunity to Telefonica Tech for a price, including the optional extensions, of £8,891,393.00.
